Legislation guides the FMPSD. FMPSD Policy 19 & 20 are in line with legislative requirements.

FMPSD Policy 19: SOGI

FMPSD Policy 20:Student Conduct / Welcoming, Caring, Respectful and Safe

Key points from guest discussion & presentation on SOGI:

- SOGI is not curriculum
- The Education Act requires that if students request a Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) teachers/school must support. GSA is not SOGI and it is not curriculum.
- The Education Act is also where pronoun use is legislated. If a student requests a change in pronouns the school administration must work with them to support safe contact with their parents to discuss.

- Professionals Respecting & Supporting Individual Sexual Minorities (PRISM) is a toolkit to support teachers. It is Alberta Teacher Association (ATA) approved. It is not curriculum.
- Alberta Health curriculum can be found online. Parents can request that children do not participate. LearnAlberta
- FMPSD does not deviate from Alberta curriculum
- If a student asks a non curriculum question teachers are guided to get back to the student in a private setting
